

Arranging a FLIGHT What does it COST Who do I CONTACT



The NWTS team is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to provide a specialist paediatric intensive care retrieval service including an advice and triaging facility. NWTS transfer infants and children below 16 years of age, including neonates, whose destination is a Paediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU).

The Transport Team includes a doctor, a retrieval nurse/s (with relevant PIC transport experience) and a dedicated ambulance with driver. For flight transfers the doctor may be an experienced trainee and/or a consultant paediatric intensivist.

A consultant paediatric intensivist is on call for NWTS 24/7



ORGANISING TRANSFERS

Please contact NWTS with patient details (brief history and clinical observations) when a child may need an emergency or semi-elective transfer to/from a PICU in the North West. One single phone call will provide expert advice on patient management during the stabilisation process. NWTS are able to organise conference calls with relevant specialists (eg burns/plastics team, surgeons, cardiologists, neurosurgeons, renal or endocrine etc) at the point of referral.

In addition, NWTS organise semi-elective transfers both in and out of region, including flight

transfers. Please call to discuss team availability as soon as a transport is planned. Final confirmation may not be possible until the day of transfer due to PICU bed availability.

FAMILIES

The NWTS team offers at least one parent the option to travel with their child, as appropriate. Our parent leaflet includes information about the service and has information about the PICUs at Alder Hey (Liverpool) and Royal Manchester Children's Hospitals.
